

# TECH276 – Coding Assignment #9

## Working with Cookies: 25 points

In this assignment you will have a chance to practice with many of the concepts and examples we looked at when dealing with cookies. You will be using the form you created for homework assignment #8 (or the sample provided if you did not complete homework #8) to set some cookies. Once they are set there should be a link to a second page that will display the elements of the cookie in a summary form.

- 1) Using the form from homework assignment #8 – set a cookie that stores the user name, email and password when the form is submitted.
- 2) The submit button on the form should link to a second page that will display the contents of the cookie.
- 3) The second page should have a form (which is clearly labeled) to display the three elements of the cookie. The form should also have a button that triggers the display of the data (the form should be blank when the page loads, and filled in when I hit the button).
- 4) Unfortunately, Chrome does not accept cookies from a local file, so test your files using Brackets or in another browser (Chrome and Dreamweaver will fail) – I will be using Brackets when I grade the homework.

The HTML, CSS and JavaScript should be in separate files (likely saved in their own folder on your USB drive). When submitting the homework, you can then just zip and submit the entire folder into Blackboard and rest assured that all the required files have been submitted. The zipped file should be submitted before class begins on the due date. This homework assignment is worth 25 points.
