

Rules of XHTML

XML

- * Documents must start with an XML declaration
- * Every document must have a single root element
- * All elements have distinct start and end tags
- * All elements are nested correctly
- * Elements/attributes must obey naming conventions
- * All attributes must have quoted values
- * Empty elements are formatted correctly

XHTML

- * Documents start with XML/DTD declarations
- * The HTML element must refer to a namespace
- * XHTML has four required tags
- * All element/attribute names must be lower-case
- * Use the “id” and “name” attributes
- * Use style sheets to control layout
- * Externalize scripts and styles
