




Slide 3

- Format Major Grid Lines
- Many dialog boxes have list on the left of categories
- Lot of graphical features




Slide 4

- Add Minor Grid Lines
- Some menu items react to a single click
- Once added, lines can then be formatted




Slide 5

- Format Y Axis
- Can affect text attributes
- Can effect values displayed
- Can effect number format
- Can effect vertical line




Slide 6

- Format Y Axis
- Axis Options
- Set max/min values to emphasize differences
- Can also be used to set standard values across multiple charts to create a common frame of reference




Slide 7

- Format Y Axis
- Number
- Standard number formats from previous versions
- [set "Number" with no decimals or thousands separator]




Slide 8

- Format Y Axis
- Alignment
- Display updates as number is advanced "live preview"
- [stop at 15, 40, and 70 degrees]
- More angle less label precision or else overlapping labels




Slide 9

- Format Y Axis
- Axis Options
- Display Units as “Thousands”
- Compare to Units as “10000”
- “10000” harder to read?



Slide 10

- Format X Axis
- Axis Options same as Y axis
- Gridlines could be added – but likely confuse rather than clarify

- Format Y Axis
- Change Font
 - Yellow text
 - Bold
